Application for Deferred Disposition

Deferred Disposition is a suspended sentence (probation). On your plea of guilty or no contest, the Judge will defer the finding of guilt until a later date, assess the applicable fees, and order you to comply with certain conditions. If you successfully comply with the terms, your case will be dismissed.

However, if you fail to comply with terms and conditions of Deferred Disposition a guilty judgment may be imposed and a conviction may be reported to the Texas Department of Public Safety in accordance with Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 27.14 (c).

You may apply for Deferred Disposition **in person** or via **certified mail** by submitting the items below **postmarked on or before** your initial court appearance indicated on your citation. The Judge will review our application and Deferred Disposition will only be granted at the discretion of Judge R. Dockery. Mail this application and the items below to:

I understand that I must present the Court the following with this signed application:

1. A copy of your valid State of Texas driver's license (Not a Commercial Driver's License – CDL)
2. Payment (Money order or cashier's Check made payable to the Whitesboro Municipal Court- contact the court to verify the appropriate amount)*Include citation number on the money order.

I understand that my request by mail will NOT be processed for the offenses listed below:

- 25 miles or more over the posted speed limit or in excess of 95 mph
- Any offense by a holder of CDL Commercial Driver's License)
- Passing a school Bus
- Any Traffic Violation that occurred in a construction zone with workers present
- Non-Traffic Cases
- Juvenile Cases (Juveniles MUST appear in person with a parent or legal guardian).

I understand that defendants younger than 25 years of age at the time of the alleged offense **are required to complete a Driver Safety Course** in addition to complying with the terms of deferred disposition by mail.

I hereby enter a plea of Guilty No Contest (Check one) on the complaint of the offense of _____(in person)(by counsel)(by certified mail) and waive my right to a jury trial. I request that the Court place me on Deferred Disposition for this case. I understand that if I successfully complete the terms of the Deferred Disposition in a timely manner, my case will be dismissed. If I do not successfully complete the terms of the Deferred Disposition, I receive a notice to appear in court to show cause why I did not complete the terms of Deferred Disposition as ordered. Furthermore, I understand that if I do not show sufficient cause, the Deferred Disposition will be revoked; a judgment of guilty entered, and may be reported to the Texas Department of Public Safety in accordance with Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 27.14 (c).
